Not-for-Profit Funding Policy

The Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) (formerly known as the Gas Tax Fund)

Purpose:

The Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) provides all municipalities across the country with a permanent, stable and indexed source of infrastructure funding. In order to participate in the CCBF, the Municipality must establish a policy under which funds can be provided to non-profit organizations in the Community to which there will be a resultant benefit to the residents of the Community.

Policy:

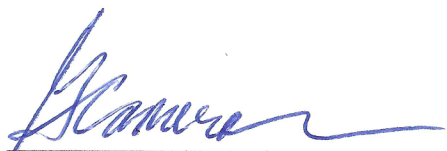
It will be the Policy of the Rural Municipality of Eastern Kings that:

- Any application from a non-profit organization for funding under the CCBF must be submitted to the Council Office at least one week prior to a Council Meeting, outlining details of the potential project, including the benefits to the Community;
- Any projects put forward by non-profit organizations to request funding through the CCBF must be discussed and approved during a monthly Council Meeting or at a special meeting called for this purpose;
- Projects approved by the Council are subject to further approval by the CCBF Project Review Committee; only projects approved by the Council will be sent forward for approval by the Project Review Committee;
- Once a final decision has been made regarding their application (approval or denial), the non-profit organization will be contacted within two weeks to discuss the decision.
